

Thank You Cards

Create the following Thank You cards in Microsoft Publisher.

Each card should:

- Have the person's name on it
- Your name on it
- A well written paragraph with details
- Have NO spelling errors
- Clipart to fill in the empty spots
- Fonts and sizes that are reasonably easy to read
- Folded neatly



1. **A card for a parent** - tell them that you appreciate them for a specific purpose. For example, letting you go to a friend's house, buying you a new bike, or something else like that.
2. **A card to Mr. Heath or Mr. Kniep** – Telling them what you like about East Minico compared to your old elementary school.
3. **A card for the Lunch Ladies** – Telling them what your favorite lunch is and something else that you like about lunch.
4. **A card for TWO of your teachers** - Tell them something you like about their class and why you like them as your teacher. You may give Mr. Larson a card but it will NOT count toward the two teachers unless you really cannot think of someone else to give a card to.
5. **A card for a friend** – Tell them why you appreciate them being your friend.
6. **Another card for anyone** – Another parent, grandparent, friend, boy\girl friend, youth leader, school librarian, school counselor, school secretary, bus driver, etc.

Put this in your portfolio!

Print a black and white one to check, and then if it is nice, print a color one to give the person. Give Mr. Larson the card for the people that work at East Minico and he will give them to each person for you once he has them all collected.
