4. ☐ The original name of the internet was ARPANET. Since we no longer use that name, replace the word "arpanet" with "internet" using the search and replace tool. It should be capitalized if it is at the beginning of a sentence or in the Bibliography.
5. ☐ Underline the following things:
  - All the side headings and indented side headings
  - Bibliography – Surfing the Internet
6. ☐ As you follow direction 7 and 8, do NOT apply bold or italic to anything that is a side heading or indented side heading. These should only be underlined.
7. ☐ Bold the following words:
  - P1 – **"NCSA Mosaic"**
  - P2 – **"Uniform Resource Locator"**
  - P3 – **"HTML" -&- "Hypertext Markup Language"**
  - P4 – **"HTTP" -&- Hypertext Transfer Protocol"**
  - P5 – **"they keep a record"**
8. ☐ Italicize the following words:
  - P1 – *"personal preference"*
  - P2 – *"government" -&- "colleges"*
  - P3 – *"IBM style" -&- "Apple style" -&- "Unix style"*
  - P4 – *"DNS Server" -&- "IP address" (both)*
  - P5 – *"inappropriate"*
9. ☐ Read the entire paper all the way through. Between the final paragraph and the bibliography write your own short paragraph between three and five sentences long that tell me at least two things you learned in this paper that you did not already know. I would also like you to tell me at least three of your favorite websites that you like to go to. When you type them in, make sure you put the www on the front and the proper ending such as .com or .edu on the end. When you do so, the computer will put a blue underline under the web address.
